



Charlestown High School Return to School Plan

Social Distancing in the Classroom

- Classroom furniture should be adjusted to rows, spaced apart as reasonably possible, and facing in the same direction as much as possible.
- Teachers should have an assigned seating arrangement at all times.
- Teachers will conduct class outside when it is appropriate and weather permits.

Movement Between Classes

- Students will walk on the right side of the hallway to avoid coming into contact with someone face to face
- Block scheduling will be utilized to increase class time and decrease time in the hallway
- Students will have access to hand sanitizers in the hallway and be allowed to use the restroom to wash their hands

Cafeteria/Meals

- There will be more stations available to access food in the cafeteria
- Tables will be moved out into the hallway and spaced out in the cafeteria
- Once students choose their seat in the cafeteria, they will not be allowed to roam the cafeteria and visit other tables.
- Upperclassmen will be encouraged to use the patio when the weather permits

Visitors

- There will be no outside guest or speakers allowed for the year
- Parents needing to meet with a staff member should call the school and make an appointment- only 1 parent will be allowed in the building at a time
- Parents signing students out should call Jami Lee in attendance when they arrive and she will send the student outside to the vehicle

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Teachers will be provided with sanitizing supplies to spray the desks and/or shared space and materials between class uses
- Teachers will be provided with sanitizer in the classroom
- Classrooms where it is appropriate and already conducive may allow students to wash their hands within the classroom as well

Masks/Face Coverings

- All students in grades 6-12 will be required to wear masks, or face coverings, in school when they are unable to social distance unless they have an underlying health issue that precludes them from wearing a mask. Also, all Greater Clark staff will be required to wear masks, or face coverings in school when they are unable to social distance unless they have an underlying health issue that precludes them from wearing a mask.
- Students will be required to refrain from wearing any mask that has inappropriate language or reference to drugs and alcohol.
