



CMS School Return to School Plan

Social Distancing in the Classroom

- Furniture will be in rows, spaced apart, facing the same direction
- Seating charts will be utilized in all classes
- Limit Sharing of high touch materials
- No assemblies or activities that combine classes

Movement Between Classes

- Transitions will be limited as CMS will utilize a block schedule
- Directional paths will be implemented in hallways
- Teams and grade levels will utilize a staggered passing time
- Restroom breaks will be scheduled by teams throughout the day with a low number of students allowed in at one time
- Student arrival and dismissal will be staggered

Cafeteria/Meals

- Additional tables will be set up in the commons hallway to socially distance
- Assigned seating will take place
- Additional time added in between each lunch in order properly clean
- Floors will be marked with appropriate standing distance while in cafeteria line
- There will be no microwaves in the cafeteria until further notice
- No students will eat in other areas of the school unless medically necessary
- Students shall wash hands before and after eating (additional sanitizer stations installed)
- Food sharing will be prohibited
- Water stations with disposable cups are available in lieu of drinking fountains

Visitors

- No classroom or lunch visitors will be allowed
- Visitors that need to speak to a staff member are highly encouraged to reach out by email or phone first
 - Appointments in the building must be scheduled through front office

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- CMS staff will all work to keep the building and surfaces clean
- Staff members will clean frequently touched surfaces throughout the day and conduct overall cleanings at the conclusion of every day
- Desks will be sanitized throughout the day. Teachers will have access to cleaning materials/supplies for their classroom
- Students will be asked to wash hands before and after using any shared materials that are required (PE, Art)

Masks/Face Coverings

- All students in grades 6-12 will be required to wear masks, or face coverings, in school
 when they are unable to social distance unless they have an underlying health issue
 that precludes them from wearing a mask. Also, all Greater Clark staff will be required
 to wear masks, or face coverings in school when they are unable to social distance
 unless they have an underlying health issue that precludes them from wearing a mask.
- All staff and students will be expected to have a mask or face covering so they are able to wear it at times when social distancing is not possible. GCCS will have masks for when students forget or lose their mask.
