Franklin Square Elementary School Return to School Plan

Social Distancing in the Classroom

- Students' desks will be spaced apart in rows facing the same direction.
- Students will use their assigned materials with no sharing.
- Students will have breakfast, lunch and some special area classes in the classroom.
- During small groups instruction students and teachers will be strongly encouraged to wear masks.

Movement Between Classes

- Directional paths will be used throughout the school building with classroom teachers' supervision.
- Several restroom and handwashing breaks will be scheduled daily.
- Students will be encouraged to wear masks in the hallways when transitioning to various areas outside the classroom.

Cafeteria/Meals

- Grades PreK-1 will eat lunch in their classroom.
- Depending on the number of students in the cafeteria Grade 2 may eat in the classroom to ensure social distancing.
- Grades 3-5 will have assigned seats in the cafeteria.
- All food and materials will be handed directly to students from staff members wearing masks and gloves.
- Food sharing will be prohibited.

Visitors

- No classroom visitors or lunch visitors.
- All visitors must have an appointment for any parent/guardian meeting. Masks will be worn during the meetings. Most parent meetings will be conducted virtually.

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- FSES staff members will clean frequently touched surfaces, desks, equipment throughout the students' day.
- Students' desks, lunchroom, restrooms and playground equipment will be sanitized frequently throughout the day.

Masks/Face Coverings

- Students will be highly encouraged to wear masks at Franklin Square Elementary School when social distancing is not possible.
- All staff members at Franklin Square Elementary School will be required to wear a
 mask/face covering during the instructional school day when social distancing is not
 possible unless they have an underlying health issue that precludes them from
 wearing a mask.
