



Parkview Middle School Return to School Plan

Social Distancing in the Classroom

- Desks and tables are placed in rows, facing the same direction and spaced apart.
- Students in assigned seats.
- Students will not share materials including Chromebooks.
- PE, Choir and Band are located in alternate locations to allow for social distancing.
- Large school assemblies are eliminated this year, and classes will not be combined.

Movement Between Classes

- Staggered block schedule keeping students in the hallway at different times.
- Each restroom has a maximum occupancy posted.
- An adult will supervise outside of the restroom for compliance.
- Students are only allowed to use certain restrooms based upon their grade level.
- PVMS will provide disposable cups to students for two touchless water fountains.
- All other water fountains will be turned off.

Cafeteria/Meals

- Self-serve items are limited.
- Service ware will be handed out by the cashier.
- Tape marks are located on the floor to promote social distancing while waiting in line.
- Increased supervision in the lunch area.
- Classes are separated with each student assigned a seating chart.
- Students are not allowed to share food.
- The cafeteria staff is required to wear face masks and disposable gloves at all times.
- Families are encouraged to put money in their online account each week to limit the number of cash transactions.

Visitors

- Masks and appointments are required for outside visitors to meet with office staff.
- Communication by phone/email/video conference is encouraged instead of face to face.
- No more than three people at a time are allowed in the reception area.
- Visitors will be screened.
- Classroom visitors are not allowed for 2020-2021.

Cleaning and Sanitizing

- Teachers will spray desks with disinfectant between each class.
- Hand sanitizers are in each classroom.
- Restrooms and high touch areas will be sprayed throughout the day.
- Hand sanitizers are placed near doors, offices, and gym spaces.

Masks/Face Coverings

- All students in grades 6-12 will be required to wear masks or face coverings in school when they are unable to socially distance unless they have an underlying health condition.
- All GCCS staff will be required to wear masks, or face coverings in school when they are unable to social distance, unless they have an underlying health issue.
