We all have a role in making the GCCS Return to School plan a success. Here are some things that you can do to help keep our classrooms, campuses, and workplaces safe for everyone.

Parents

- Talk to your student about [hand washing and hygiene](#). Those messages should be consistently reinforced at school and at home.
- If your student displays any of the [symptoms of COVID-19](#) please do not send them to school. When exhibiting symptoms, your student should [stay at home except to seek medical attention](#).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at school, subject to availability, but we encourage parents to provide their student(s) with a small container of hand sanitizer to bring to school.
- Familiarize yourself with the rules for visiting your student's school.

Students

- Make it a habit to wash your hands several times each day.
- If you notice that a soap dispenser is empty or nearly empty, notify your teacher or other responsible adult.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at school, but we encourage you to bring your own small container of hand sanitizer.

Employees

- Get in the habit of washing your hands several times each day.
- If you experience any of the [symptoms of COVID-19](#) please do not report to work. When exhibiting symptoms, notify your supervisor, and [stay at home except to seek medical attention](#).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at your workplace, subject to availability, but we encourage you to bring your own small container of hand sanitizer.
